

### General information

- Reservations
  - Inquire by phone for reservations.
  - Some activities may not be available due to inclement weather and/or crop conditions, regardless of the specified operating dates.
  - Some activities may also be available outside of the specified operating dates. For more information, please inquire using the contact information below.
  - Some plans have a maximum group size. We recommend making your reservation as soon as possible.
- Terms and conditions
  - Before making a reservation, check the terms and conditions on the back cover of this pamphlet as well as the information on the page for the activity you wish to participate in.
- Tour conductors
  - Tour conductors will not accompany you, unless otherwise specified. If changes to the service are required due to situations such as inclement weather, customers will be responsible for making alternative arrangements and carrying out necessary procedures.
- Cancellation fees
  - Unless otherwise stated, cancellation fees are as follows: no fee for cancellations 3 days or more before the activity; 50% fee for cancellations after 5 pm 2 days before the activity; 100% fee for cancellations after 5 pm the day before the activity and for no-shows. A refund processing fee of 100 yen plus tax will be charged for each cancellation.
- Prices
  - Prices and travel costs include taxes and service charges.
  - Unless otherwise stated, "adult" is defined as age 12 and over, "child" is defined as age 6-11 and "infant" is defined as age 5 and under, based on participants' age on the

day of the activity. For some activities, infants may be charged children's rates or be unable to participate.

- Children and infants may only participate when accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Scheduled times
  - Specified departure and arrival times are approximate and may be subject to change.
- For wheelchair users and people with assistance dogs

- The specified length of activities includes travel time.
- Unless otherwise specified, there will be no pick-up or drop-off service. Customers are responsible for making their own way to and from the venue.

Terms and conditions of tours This information is a summary only. Please pick up and read the full terms and conditions of your tour before making your reservation.

#### Terms and conditions for all plans

Please confirm the terms and conditions specific to your plan when making your reservation. There are two types of contracts depending on the plan: agent-organized tours and tours arranged per customer request. These are indicated by **Tourism Plan** and **Arranged Tour** respectively.

- Handling of personal information
  - (1) Iwamizawa Tourism Association and sales outlets may use personal information from customers' reservation forms to communicate with customers and/or arrange services from accommodation and transport providers as part of the customer's tour.
  - (2) Iwamizawa Tourism Association may provide personal information held on customers to souvenir stores in order to provide a more convenient shopping experience at the destination. In these cases, personal information relating to customers' names and flight numbers will be sent in advance electronically or by other means. Customers who do not wish for this information to be provided should contact the outlet where they made the reservation before departure.

#### Arranged Tours Arranged tour contract

Customers who reserve tours with this symbol will enter into an arranged tour contract with the travel agency listed as the sales outlet. In addition to the following provisions, arranged tours shall be subject to separately supplied terms of service (full text) and the arranged tour contract section of the terms and conditions of the travel agency with which the reservation is made. Please refer to the arranged tours section of the terms and conditions of the relevant travel agency for information regarding points not covered here.

- Tour reservations and conclusion of contract
  - (1) Please fill out the required items on the reservation form and pay a deposit for 20% of the cost of the tour when submitting your reservation. This deposit will be deducted from the final total of any fees to be paid by the customer (tour costs, cancellation fees, etc.)
  - (2) Arranged tour contracts are effective once the contract has been accepted by the travel agency with which the reservation has been made and the deposit has been received.
  - (3) Verbal agreements may also be accepted when arranging single elements such as travel tickets and accommodation vouchers. In these cases, arranged tour contracts are effective once the verbal agreement is made with the travel agency with which the reservation has been made.

- Travel service handling fees

The travel agency with which the reservation is made may charge travel service handling fees or other fees as prescribed by the company for processes such as coordination, alterations and cancellations relating to your tour reservation, along with consumption tax on those fees. - Cancellation fees
  - (1) Cancellations

If you have travel tickets, accommodation vouchers or similar, the remaining amount after subtracting relevant fees from the cost will be refunded in exchange for the tickets, vouchers and similar. Refunds will be handled by the travel agency with which you made the reservation within one month of the date of issue or date of use. Cancellation and penalty fees prescribed by transportation or accommodation providers vary depending on the provider. Please ask a member of staff for more details.

- (2) Partial cancellations of accommodation on the day (reduction in the number of guests)

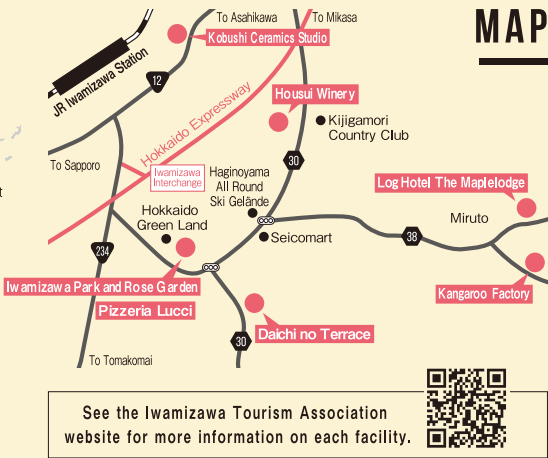

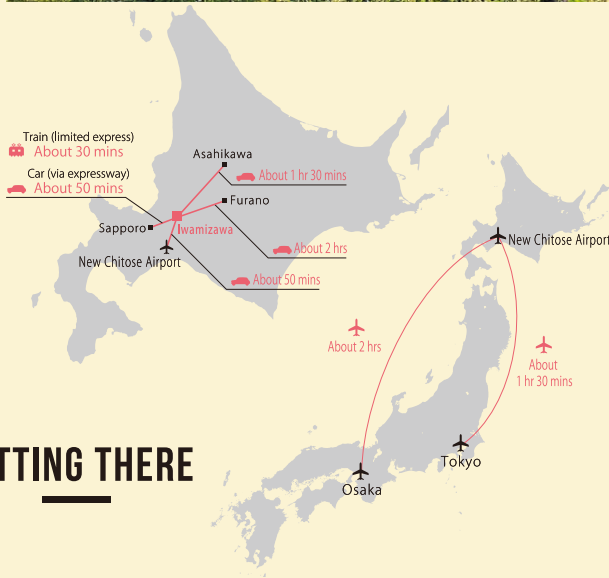

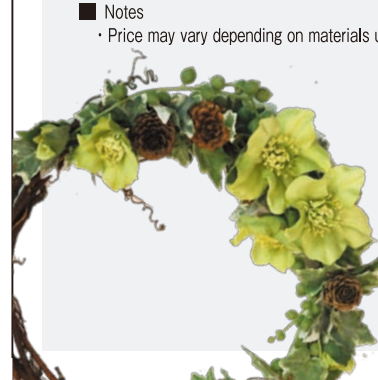
